The Loacker 2018 Brunello di Montalcino Corte Pavone Fiore del Vento boasts a very vibrant dark garnet color. The appearance of this organic and biodynamic wine is pretty to admire, and there is a lifted note on the bouquet with dried cherry skin and raspberry tart. A faint aldehydic note gives this wine its vertical intensity.

Clean and bright blackberry, even blackcurrant character to this with a medium- to full-bodied palate and an intense finish of firm, fruit-soaked tannins. This is very tight and firm just now and clearly needs some time in the bottle. But when this bright, youthful Brunello broadens out it will be superb. From organically grown grapes. Try from 2025.



WINE ENTHUSIAST

The palate is dark and sophisticated, as berries flirt with more savory notes of dark chocolate, graphite and spices. On the palate, there's a spark between the berries and the dark chocolate specifically, which can be felt on the peppery finish, but polished tannins give a slick texture.
