2021 CABERNET SAUVIGNON

PASO ROBLES, CALIFORNIA, USA

WINEMAKING

This premium Paso Robles Esser Cabernet Sauvignon was produced from sustainably farmed vineyards in picturesque Paso Robles County. These grapes benefit from a long growing season, abundant sunshine, and cool evening breezes, resulting in a wine that expresses terroir and true varietal character. The growing season was excellent with a refined balance of soft rains with no extended heat periods. The fruit was picked in the early morning hours and processed at the nearby winery to be aged in both American Oak 20% and New Hungarian Oak 20% for 6 months.

COLOR

Deep dark ruby color.

AROMA

Lush aromas of cassis, dark cherry, blueberry, cedar, anise, and subtle ripe black olive (oil cured).

PALATE

Notes of ripe red fruit open up to a broad medium weight middle palate with flavors of ripe red and black fruits. The broad structure is framed by fresh acidity and well integrated tannins that support a clean and lengthy finish. Flavor notes of bright cherry, red and black currant, cedar, anise and chocolate (cocoa nibs)
