WHAT YOU'LL TASTE

Aromas of toasty oak, red cherry, wild strawberry, and cherry cola. On the palate, you'll taste fresh raspberry, rhubarb, cola, dark plum, with subtle umami and mineral notes. This wine has a long finish ending with hints of black pepper. Rich flavors of cherry, pomegranate, sweet cranberry and baking spice.

WHAT TO SERVE

A classic pairing for wild caught salmon roasted on a cedar plank. Hearty mushroom risotto or pasta dishes are sure to make this wine sing.
