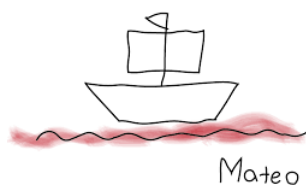

Little Boat Rosé Sonoma County 2024

Crafted primarily from Pinot Noir, with small additions of Zinfandel, Syrah, and Chardonnay, our 2024 Rosé is a vibrant expression of Sonoma County. Sourced from premier vineyards across the Russian River Valley, Dry Creek Valley, Sonoma Valley, and the Sonoma Coast, this wine reflects the diversity and character of each sub-appellation.

Each varietal was whole-cluster pressed and cold-fermented separately in stainless steel drums at temperatures below 58°F to preserve freshness and aromatics. The final blend was carefully assembled to achieve the ideal balance of color, alcohol, and acidity. Brilliant wild salmon in hue, the wine opens with aromas of cherry, strawberry, and tangerine, lifted by a note of citrus cream. The palate is elegant and fruit-driven, with a creamy mid-palate texture and a clean, refreshing finish that lingers with finesse.
