The Loacker 2018 Brunello di Montalcino Corte Pavone Campo Marzio (a biodynamic and organic wine from a site with galestro and clay soils) reveals a dark ruby color and pretty transparency. This bouquet is tonic and bright with **crisp cherry, blueberry and lavender bud**. That **freshness goes a long way** to give lift and vertical push to the bouquet.

I like the savory element that colors the ripe berry fruit here. It's something like wild onion or kalonji and **adds another dimension** to this medium- to full-bodied red with **very fine tannins** and the same, attractive blend of fruity and savory notes through the long finish. From organically grown grapes. Drinkable now, but tempting to see how this develops.
