Winemaking

Hapa Blanc has always been inspired by our love of Châteauneuf du Pape white blends, which is why we frame the wine around Roussanne and all its amazing texture and beauty. The Viognier, Sauvignon Blanc, Grenache Blanc, Vermentino, Riesling and Arneis help to elevate aromatics, while lengthening the wine and bring amazing complexity to the blend. Roussanne was fermented in neutral french barrels. The blend was then aged 11 months in Neutral French barrels with 8% in new Acacia barrels.

Tasting Notes

Bright aromas of golden apple, pear, and pineapple, along with hints of vanilla, starfruit, jasmine and baker's spice. Juicy upfront flavors of pineapple, Asian pear and melon, lead to an exotic core of honeysuckle, beeswax, starfruit, mineral, and spice, finishing with balanced acidity and lasting flavor.
