2021 PINOT NOIR

SONOMA MOUNTAIN, SONOMA COUNTY

WINE NOTES Comprised of California Heritage selections that, along with non-interventionist winemaking techniques, allows Sonoma Mountain's strong personality to take center stage in this dark-fruited, boldly structured Pinot Noir.

VINEYARD Sourced from multiple hillside sites residing up to 1100' on the northwest side of Sonoma Mountain. These terroirs contribute minerality and savoriness which beautifully complements Sonoma's fruitful exuberance.

WINEMAKER NOTES *A vintage that required close attention to be paid to both skin ripeness on the vine, then tannin extraction during ferment. This led 2021 to be a later than normal harvest, with short ferments and powerful wines. The resulting wine is a powerfully fruited Pinot Noir, with significant structure, and mineral-driven complexities well informed by Sonoma Mountain's classic black tea notes.*
