
SONOMA MOUNTAIN, SONOMA COUNTY

WINE NOTES Raised with minimalistic methods, including native fermentations, and minimal new oak impact. Dark, deep and intense, this AVA is proving to be one of Sonoma's top terroirs for the variety.

VINEYARD Multiple sources dotting the hillsides of Sonoma Mountain's northwest corner. These ocean-influenced, high-altitude sites bear intensely flavored Syrah of a savory, and floral nature, balancing California's natural tendency towards fruit-forwardness.

WINEMAKER NOTES – *An unbridled extrovert that demands attention from start to finish. Impenetrably dark, the wine pours an unctuous, purple/black violet. Swirling releases a rush of dark earth and savage aromatics, laced with smoked meats. In the mouth, a bold expression of textures span out across the palate, heralding an intensely masculine expression of Syrah informed by bold black fruits, anise and strong notes of garrigue.*
