BASTARD TONGUE, SONOMA COUNTY

WINE NOTES Since 2011, ‘BT’ has remained the popstar of Argot’s portfolio. A barrel selection wine that puts on display the magnificence of Sonoma County’s terroir—that specific balance of opulent fruit, silky textures, and savory complexity.

NOTES Sourced from cool-climate vineyards spread across Sonoma County with a focus on the Sonoma Mountain and Bennett Valley AVAs. Each site contributes expert expressions of the county’s terroir with a farming ethos strictly informed by quality-over-quantity.

WINEMAKER NOTES A warm summer led to an earlier-than-usual, smooth start to harvest season, before Labor Day’s record-setting heatwave interrupted this flow. In a vintage saving break, the oppressive heat was followed by a week-long stretch of 70-degree days, during which our remaining Pinot Noir was harvested at ideal ripeness. The strictest selection was paramount in 2022—on the vine, at the sorting table and during assemblage.
