Estate Michel THIBAUT

Michel THIBAUT, winemaker in the Jura since 1989, is developing his own wine estate with his wife in 2014.

To the south of Arbois on “La route des vins du Jura” (the Jura wine road) is located Poligny, a small town of character surrounded by a vineyard in the Côtes du Jura appellation.

In 2016, the estate committed itself and obtained the Terra Vitis certification:

Human and environmental issues are at the heart of the Terra Vitis project. The protection of natural resources is one of the major issues but not the only one. The health of the farm manager, his employees, his neighbors and consumers are all equally important to Terra Vitis.

In 2018, Hubert, the eldest son, joined the family winery after having discovered different vineyards, in particular the Costières de Nîmes, where he was cellar master at Château de la Tuilerie owned by Chantal Comte.

The wines of the Estate MICHEL THIBAUT have been produced with the same philosophy for more than twenty-five years, the aim being to obtain Côtes du Jura wines that are rich in flavor and accessible.

In Poligny, the vineyard occupies 3 distinct favorable zones at the mouth of the reculée, areas surrounding the expansion of the city.

The soils are made up successively of gravel fallen from the cliff, limestones with gryphae (fossilized oysters) and black marls covered with silts.

It forms three relatively different entities in terms of soils and exposure.

The upper part of the wine-growing hillsides of Poligny is covered by a thick (3 to 10 feet) cover of scree from the dominant cliffs of the plateau. This cover is in the shape of vast flows that have spread from the cliff to the base of the slope. This high production of scree was done during the last cold phases of the Quaternary.

The Chevraudes hillside dominates the Charcigny district. Facing south/southwest, it rests on a thick layer of scree from the limestone of the great cornice.

Soils rich in gravel make the specificity of Poligny wines.
