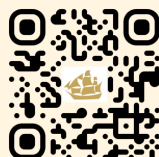

## Château Gazin Rocquencourt

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### HISTORY

*Acquired at the end of 2005 by the Bonnie family, who also owns the Classified Growth Château Malartic-Lagravière, Château Gazin Rocquencourt's origins dates back to the Middle Ages.*

*Founded in the 15th century, it is considered to be one of the oldest wine properties in the township of Léognan, with the first traces of vines dating back to 1468, when it was owned by Guillem de Gazen.*

*Part of the Bonnie family is currently living at the château, which dates from 1660.*

*Located south of Bordeaux in the prestigious Pessac-Léognan Appellation, at the northern edge of the Graves region, Gazin Rocquencourt enjoys an exceptional setting on a gravelly hillside along the left bank of the Eau Blanche River. The vineyard is certified for Sustainable Viticulture and High Environmental Value (HEV), reflecting the environmental commitments shared across all Bonnie family estates.*

*Applying agroecological principles, a manual, minimal intervention approach is taken, with plant cover maintained by plough horses, a flock of sheep and the resident geese.*

*Every aspect is subject to rigorous quality standards, managed by the Malartic team.*

*Produced from this ancestral terroir, the wines of Gazin Rocquencourt have superb ageing potential and are widely praised by professional wine critics. They have thus consolidated their position among the jewels of the Pessac-Léognan appellation.*



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### THE WINES

*Situated a few hundred metres from Château Malartic-Lagravière, the 22 hectare-vineyard of Gazin Rocquencourt has always benefited from the same care as the Grand Cru Classé.*

*Today, the vines of Gazin Rocquencourt are integrated into Malartic's vineyard, and are farmed by the Malartic teams in order to produce, when the vintage allows, a "cuvée" exclusively sourced from the original plots, that reflects the unique character of this centuries-old property.*

*It is through a constant pursuit of quality and with the support of highly skilled and dedicated teams that the Bonnie family passionately crafts the wines of Vignobles Malartic.*

*With a unique selection of Merlots and Cabernets from the property for the reds, and Sauvignons for the whites, these wines highlight the soul and expression of the terroir of this remarkable property.*

*Vintage after vintage, the wines of Gazin Rocquencourt brilliantly express the nobility and identity of their terroirs.*
